Seeding will be based by won-loss record, head to head if 2 tied, if there are any places tied the tiebreaker will be as follows:

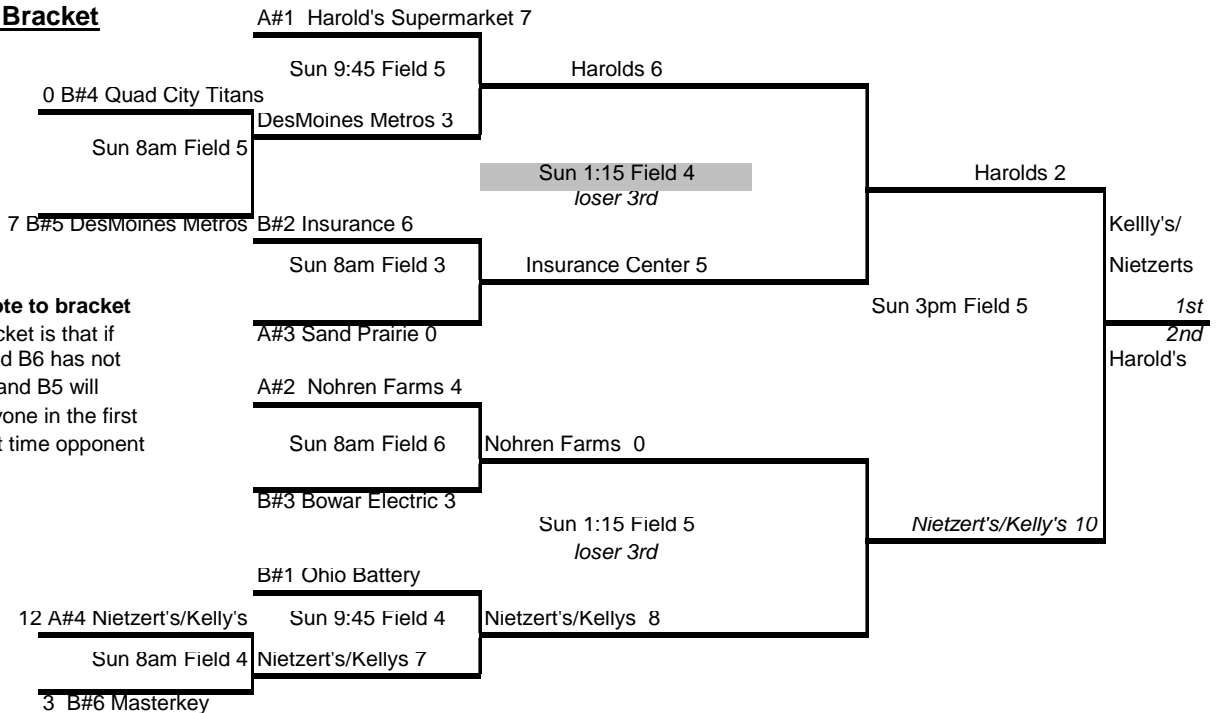
total runs scored minus runs allowed is the first tiebreaker, if you can seed all tied teams using

If they are still tied after these methods then used runs scored as a third tiebreaker, if still tied use coin flip
